Collection Drives:

To make giving as simple as possible, we have created multiple online and physical opportunities. Further, we have removed the date timeframe restrictions on when you can give certain items. For example, if you want to host a collection drive of STEM toys, you may now do so at any time of year, and not only during the holidays. In another example, you may collect and/or purchase new gifts for the Baby Showers whenever it is convenient.

If you are hosting a collection drive at your place of business, either by utilizing Amazon Lists or a Physical Collection Drive, a fun way to participate is to offer internal incentives to the employees. For example, the winning team members receive a casual day at work, or a competition for the highest donor receives a day off work, or the winning team receives an ice cream social hour, etc.

Option #4: Amazon Collection Drives – simply select a list below (or use several lists), purchase a suggested gift item(s), which will then ship to MCC directly. Also, this is an excellent way to include others.

MCC has been the recipient of grant opportunities by individual employees nominating our non-profit to receive funds.

Option #10: MCC National Network - Designed Specifically for Small, Medium & Large Retail Companies

“Take the Pledge to Commit to Annually Support U.S. Military Children!”

Join the new “MCC National Network” and let Americans know that you are a business that is *all in* to support our U.S. Military Families. It’s incredibly simple!

Step 1) Commit to hosting an Annual Collection Drive, at every retail store location you have. If you are national, host a Collection Drive at one store within each county where you have a retail location.

Step 2) Once you take the pledge, MCC will coordinate with the local Military Installation/Commands in that area to ensure that the gift donations your customers purchase are recovered, inventoried and arrive to the U.S. Military Children and Teens that they are intended for. For example, you can ask Americans to purchase a new book, or Easter Basket(s) or Backpack(s) and School Supplies, or Baby Shower items, Clothing, Sporting Equipment, etc.

Step 3) Pledge to make a meaningful monetary contribution back to MCC, once a year, from all the profits your company will earn by offering everyday Americans the opportunity to purchase a new gift directly in your store for a Military Child or Teen, above their already planned purchase(s) at your retail establishment.

Step 4) Enjoy the opportunity to confirm to Americans that your business cares about the sacrifices of our U.S. Military Families serving at freedom’s door.
