Easter Baskets & Supplies Collection & Donation Guidelines

Introduction:

Military Children's Charity, originally founded in 2010, has a mission to acknowledge and recognize the children of American Service members. The Easter (aka Spring Season) collection drive is one of MCC's flagship programs. Thank you for stepping forward to participate with the donation of new Easter Baskets and supplies to assemble new baskets!

Your support is helping MCC to contribute moments of play, creativity and imagination. With purpose, these gifts remind our Military Children (and their families) that American's care about their repeated sacrifices. Please closely review the following guidelines to ensure a successful collection drive. Throughout the year, MCC collects and distributes thousands of gifts across multiple branches of the U.S. Armed Forces. Our team knows from sixteen years of experience that the more organized your collection drive is in advance, the more successful your results will be.

Gifting Guidelines:

- ✓ Please do not advance cellophane wrap any of the Easter Baskets or supplies; all items must be **UNWRAPPED**. If wrapped, our volunteers must then *unwrap* them before delivery to the U.S. military. Leaving items bought in original packaging is okay.
- ✓ As a non-profit organization, M.C.C. accepts only **NEW** items for our U.S. Military Children and their families, to say thank you. M.C.C. **will not accept used** or even **gently used** items. If you donate an item that we determine is *used*, we will be annoyed and must then spend volunteer time re-donating it elsewhere.
- ✓ Please plan to deliver what you have collected to one of MCC's volunteer team members, because our all-volunteer organization **does not own a vehicle, and we do not drive to pick up the** donations collected from you. **It is 100% your responsibility to get them delivered to an MCC volunteer point of contact. We ask that you work out in advance on 1) when you will deliver, 2) who is assigned from your group, 3) to whom in MCC you will deliver to, and 4) to where you will meet team MCC before you begin a collection drive.**
- ✓ MCC loves ❤ to utilize larger sand pails with shovels, as the physical Easter basket and then fill it with goodies. This allows the child to find further use for the sand bucket during the year.
- ✓ Please remember the teenagers! The teens are often overlooked by the donations that we receive. They like gift cards in reasonable amounts, like \$10 to \$20 each, (to fun places such as movie theaters, frozen yogurt, Starbucks), that we can incorporate into a small basket with additional goodies, like candy, make-up, games, etc.
- ✓ Also, please do not forget the babies; items for newborns to 2-year-olds are very much desired.
- ✓ MCC does not accept religious items to give to U.S. Military Children and their Families.
- ✓ Please do not leave notes inside the baskets, they will be removed. However, you are welcome and encouraged to include an unsealed greeting card of support and appreciation.
- ✓ Incorporating new STEM focused toys and books inside of the Easter Basket(s) is a bonus.
- ✓ Please **do not** donate recycled, dusty, funky smelling stuffed animals. This is gross, please do not do it.
- ✓ Please **do not** donate any **perishable items, food, baby formula, or candy**. MCC purchases all new food and candy fresh that is distributed to the U.S. military families from stores directly. Instead, please consider donating to MCC a Gift Card to a grocery store, Target, Walmart, etc. so our volunteers can purchase those items.
- ✓ If you collect any items in bulk, such as large cellophane bags, Easter Basket grass filling, baskets/sand pails, plastic Easter eggs, curly ribbons, scotch tape, stuffed animals, books, small gifts, (etc.) this is fantastic too! At the end of the collection, our team will assemble Easter baskets from all the miscellaneous supplies received.

Summary Recap:


1. Do not wrap anything you are donating, even the Easter Baskets.
2. No *used* or *gently used* gifts – especially stinky stuffed animals.
3. You must plan and deliver your collection of new Easter gift donations to an MCC point of contact.
4. No religious gifts are accepted by MCC.
5. We encourage Americans to include an unsealed greeting card of appreciation.
6. Adding a new STEM toy and/or book into the Basket is highly recommended.
